Over six months, nonprofit leaders strengthen their fundraising and storytelling skills, supported by SVP Partners and volunteers who contribute their time, talent, and connections.



# Highlights

- 6–8 BIPOC-led nonprofits (typically under \$500K budgets)
- 12–20 SVP Partners and volunteers engaged as thought partners and reviewers
- 6-month learning cohort (Jan– Jun 2026)
- Culminates in the Stories of Impact Showcase celebrating community innovation

### Investing in Equity, Relationships, and Community Leadership

Across King County, small, BIPOC-led nonprofits are driving powerful solutions to today's most urgent challenges—yet they receive only a fraction of available funding and visibility.

GrowFundMe responds to this gap by investing in capacity, connection, and collective learning by:

- Strengthening fundraising and storytelling capacity
- Expanding networks between nonprofits, funders, and allies
- Demonstrateing an equity-centered model of philanthropy
- Mobilizing new funding for grassroots organizations



#### A Six-Month Journey of Shared Learning and Action



**Kickoff & Goal Setting (January):** Trust-building, introductions, and fundraising fundamentals

**Workshops (Feb-Apr):** Fundraising, case-making, and storytelling with expert instructors

**Thought Partnership:** Monthly check-ins between nonprofits and SVP Partners

**Showcase Prep (May):** Presentation coaching and practice

**Stories of Impact Showcase (June):** Nonprofits present to 100–150 community and business leaders; pooled funds distributed equally
